ABOUT THE ROLE:

First Tee – Massachusetts is seeking to fill the position of Operations Coordinator with an energetic and enthusiastic individual who fully embraces First Tee's mission of teaching kids and teens crucial life skills and character values through golf. We Build Game Changers!

The Operations Coordinator will serve a key support role centered around administration, communication, and customer service. This person must possess strong organizational and communication skills, be technologically savvy, and demonstrate a high level of personal integrity.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Administration
 - Manage schedules, registration, participant data, and facility data for all First Tee classes using the Salesforce CRM and parent registration portal
 - Primary point of contact for parents and coaches seeking assistance with registration issues and account help, or general questions and information about the First Tee Program, First Tee Participant App, or First Tee Coach App
 - o Support onboarding of new coaches and volunteers
 - Contribute to planning and operating annual golf tournament fundraiser
 - Assist with monitoring coach & volunteer compliance with SafeSport requirements
 - Contribute to reporting of metrics and benchmarks to First Tee Committee, First Tee HQ, and Mass Golf Board of Directors

Communication

- Coordinate with Lead Coaches and facility representatives from locations around the state to establish seasonal program schedules
- Update and maintain the chapter website using basic web management tools (WordPress)





- o Publicize registration open dates and support participant recruitment
- Maintain the chapter's social media accounts (primarily Facebook and Instagram), keeping them updated with timely and relevant content
- Collect data from First Tee Community Partner and First Tee Schools Programs to ensure accurate contact information, track equipment needs, and report participation numbers
- Program Support (Occasional)
 - o Travel to support off-site events and participant opportunities
 - Attend and represent First Tee Massachusetts at fundraising events, participant opportunities, and Mass Golf engagements
 - o Attend First Tee classes if needed
