The focus of this internship will involve teaching various levels of youth golf along with assisting and coaching our PGA Jr League and delivering programming to our partners at YMCA and Challenge Mountain where we teach the disabled. This internship will run from May 20th through August 16th, 2023 (or very close to these dates) at The Highlands at Harbor Springs and surrounding area.

- Be willing to speak and lead participants who range in age from 5-17
- Maintain professional appearance and conduct to set a positive example for young people
