 - Collaborate with the programming team to coordinate a robust schedule of volunteer and coach trainings, including First Tee and other training opportunities
 - o Ability to travel to offsite visits and meetings

 - o Ensure all reporting is timely and complete
 - Meet budget goals
 - o Maintain all required paperwork, online and otherwise
 - o Actively maintain records in SalesForce
- Member of First Tee Phoenix team
 - Collaborate with FT team to ensure adequate volunteers at events, clinics, tournaments, fundraisers, classes, etc.
 - Attend First Tee coach trainings
 - o Participate in tournaments and special events
 - o Other duties as assigned
