Responsibilities:

- Act as coach at all required FTGVR classes (includes Saturdays) implementing golf and life skills
- Ensure that classes are set up according to the lesson plan prior to the start of the scheduled lesson
- Assist with inventory management
- Become comfortable using Salesforce
- Update class registrations
- Periodically mentor for and/or run Friday Play Days
- Adhere to the standards of the First Tee Code of Conduct
- Content contribution to Monthly Newsletter
- Provide office administrative support
- Fulfillment of duties during the Colorado Open Championships (pre, post, and during events)
